TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The Kidsafe 2010 National Playspace Design Awards is open to individuals and organisations from all sectors, including service providers, design professionals, students, landscape contractors and playground providers. Kidsafe employees/ representatives are not eligible to enter.
2. Entrants must ensure that playspace project entries are completed playspaces within Australia, installed/ constructed since September 2006, currently open for use and have not been submitted for previous Kidsafe National Playspace Design Awards.
3. A project may not be entered into more than one category.
4. Entries for the Kidsafe 2010 National Playspace Design Awards must be emailed to the *Kidsafe NSW* Playground Advisory Unit at: kidsafe@chw.edu.au. Entries must be received by 5.00pm AEST Tuesday 31 August 2010.
5. Kidsafe reserves the right to transfer entries between categories where considered appropriate in consultation with submitting organisations.
6. Entries that do not submit information and images in the form required will not be considered by the judging panel. Word limits and file format /size stipulated for entries must be complied with.
7. Kidsafe or any of its employees/representatives shall not be liable for any loss or damage to entries from whatsoever cause arising while in their custody, possession or control, nor shall they be liable for any loss arising from misdirected or lost entries.
8. Entries must not infringe the rights (including copyright) of any other person.
9. Where entry files include images of a person or people, it is the responsibility of the entrant to ensure that each person appearing has signed a release form.
10. An Award of Excellence and Certificate of Merit will be made per category, subject to discretion of the judging panel. Awards and certificates will be endorsed with the Kidsafe logo and refer to the Kidsafe 2010 National Playspace Design Awards, Category, Project Name and Entrant name. No awards of monetary value or other will be presented.
11. Award winners will be announced as part of National Kidsafe Day celebrations on Tuesday 26 October 2010. Winners will be notified by telephone or email prior to this date.
12. The judging panel's decision will be final and no correspondence entered into either during or after the awards program.
13. Images submitted may be used during the award presentation ceremonies and for other promotional and advocacy initiatives. In the case that successful playspaces are to be featured in a Kidsafe publication, written consent would be sought from the relevant stakeholders.
14. Kidsafe reserves the right to vary these terms and conditions, as required to clarify any conditions of entry.
