Visual (Routine) Playground Inspection Course

This nationally recognised training course incorporating *AHCPGD206 Conduct visual inspection of park facilities*, provides participants with the knowledge and skills to conduct routine inspections to identify visual hazards in parks, recreational facilities and playgrounds.

Who should attend?

Individuals responsible for the routine visual inspection of parks, recreational facilities and playgrounds.

This may include playground owners/operators, maintenance personnel, risk assessors, safety officers, auditors, teachers and educators.

Entry Requirements

This course requires the satisfactory completion of oral, practical demonstration and written tasks. There are no specific entry requirements for *AHCPGD206 Conduct visual inspection of park facilities*, however a general command of spoken and written English, as well as the ability to write a simple report is required.

Cost
